NEW BUSINESS:

A motion was made by Lisa Schulte and seconded by Otto Mayer to enroll in the MOGEMT program, a Missouri Reimbursement program for uncompensated cost to eligible providers. Ground Emergency Medical Transportation (GEMT), who provide ambulance services to MO healthnet participants are eligible with Dennis Scheidegger, Jim Oncken and Glenn Brandt voting favorably.

A motion was made by Dennis Scheidegger and seconded by Glenn Brandt to accept the 2019 Budget revision #2 to cover the rest of 2019, with Lisa Schulte, Otto Mayer and Jim Oncken voting favorably.

Doug Clark discussed that he is working on the 2020 budget.

A motion was made by Dennis Scheidegger and seconded by Lisa Schulte to raise the hourly rate for all Administrative personnel and Operational personnel by \$.35 an hour; the Administrator will receive a \$50.00 bi-weekly increase. This change is effective 10/6/19. All Full Time Operational personnel will receive an additional 24 hours Paid Time Off and the Administrative personnel will receive an additional 8 hours Paid Time Off, effective 1/1/20 with Glenn Brandt, Otto Mayer and Jim Oncken voting favorably.
